



**Marcus Kurth**

Professor of Control and Systems Engineering



Prof. Dr.-Ing. Marcus Kurth is a Professor of Control and Systems Engineering at the HTWG Constance and member of the Institute of System Dynamics. He studied Technical Cybernetics at the University of Stuttgart (DE) and Systems and Control Engineering at the University of Exeter (UK). After his work as scientific assistant and his doctorate at the University of Stuttgart, he became head of the Power Generation and Automation Technology Department at the Institute of Combustion and Power Plant Technology there in 2003. From 2006 to 2011, he was with Evonik Energy Services GmbH in Essen - among other responsibilities he was head of Advanced Process Control. In September 2011, he was appointed to the University of Applied Science HTWG Constance. Since 2015 he is head of the Model Factory Industry 4.0 at the HTWG Constance. And since 2016 he is CEO of Modellfabrik Bodensee GmbH with the brand varity for industrial VR and AR applications.
